Outcome 1

Describe soil-less growing media used in horticulture.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Describe soil-less growing media types used in New Zealand in terms of their common uses.
- 1.2 Describe each media type in terms of their characteristics and constituents.
- 1.3 Describe soil-less growing medium in terms of the economic factors to be considered in the selection for each type.

Range biological, chemical, physical;
 set-up costs, availability, life, management costs.

Outcome 2

Grow crops and specimens in soil-less growing media.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Prepare the media to meet requirements of defined crops or specimens.
- 2.2 Select the plant nutrients to meet crop or specimen requirements and apply using methods which maximise their effectiveness in the growing media used.
- 2.3 Apply hygiene procedures to prevent contamination of the growing medium.
- 2.4 Monitor the crop or specimen health to provide early recognition of a growing medium based problem and implement pre-defined procedures for dealing with that problem.
- 2.5 Dispose of unwanted growing media in relation to site hygiene and environmental requirements specified by the local authority are met.
