3 Ākonga will keep a fully documented photographic visual diary or workbook to assist with assessment and authenticity. This includes photographs of artwork/s.

4 Ākonga are encouraged to ensure exhibition deadlines (i.e. labels, postage of taonga Māori) are met.

5 Definitions

Exhibition refers to local, regional, national, or international exhibition.

Exhibited – where ākonga are unable to attend exhibition, ākonga must request image/s to verify taonga Māori were displayed within exhibition space; other forms of evidence may include thank you letters or certificates of participation.

Taonga Māori refers to – digital, graphic design, whakairo, paint, print, sculpture, uku, Ngā Mahi a Te Whare Pora.

6 Referencing of all sources of information is encouraged. Referencing will prepare ākonga for the requirements of academic writing.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Provide information for the exhibition.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Ākonga biography is written for exhibition.
- Range includes but is not limited to – iwi, hapū details; school/provider; year of study; inspiration behind completed work (taonga Māori).
- 1.2 Specifications of taonga Māori are provided.
- Range includes but is not limited to – title of work, description of work, explanation, materials/media, dimensions, weight (if applicable); high resolution image is required.

Outcome 2

Prepare and exhibit taonga Māori.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Taonga Māori are prepared to display at the exhibition.
- Range may include but is not limited to – packaging requirements (bubble wrap, heavy duty cardboard, wood), hooks, framing, display instructions, label, return address details, contact telephone number, email address.
- 2.2 Taonga Māori are exhibited.
