- 2 Definitions

New Zealand Riding for the Disabled (NZRDA) is the parent body of riding for the disabled. All riding for disabled affiliated groups are referred to as *Riding for the Disabled (RDA)*.

NZRDA standards refer to policies and procedures set by the NZRDA which are available on the Group Resource Library, NZRDA The Stable <https://thestable.rda.org.nz/s/>. NZRDA standards reflect current legislation.

- 3 For the purposes of assessment:
 - evidence must be presented in accordance with NZRDA standards.

Review a RDA session.

- 1.1 Review session outcomes against the session plan and feedback from riders, volunteers, and therapist to determine if session short term goals are met.
- 1.2 Report on review outcomes.
- 1.3 Recommend improvements to the session.

Outcome 2

Complete rider records, and review rider progression.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Complete rider records.
- 2.2 Review rider progression according to rider's short term goals and individual learning plan, and make adjustments to the learning plan if required.
