- 3 For the purposes of assessment:

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Plan for, and supervise riders to mount in preparation for a RDA session.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Identify assistance required, and pre-check resources and safety requirements.
- 1.2 Brief assistants and riders involved in mounting procedure.
- 1.3 Demonstrate and supervise mounting procedure from specialised mobility equipment to mounting position.
 - Range specialised mobility equipment must include wheelchair; may include walking frame, crutches.
- 1.4 Supervise mounting procedure with sidewalkers positioned in a manner which maintains their personal safety, and horse is in best position to receive riders.

Outcome 2

Demonstrate and supervise physical support, physical assistance, transferring, and dismounting riders following a RDA session.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Demonstrate and supervise physical support, physical assistance and transferring of the rider during the RDA session.
- 2.2 Demonstrate and supervise dismounting procedure from the horse to specialised mobility equipment.
