- 1.3 Apply the concept of whānau tangata to develop curriculum activities that inform instruction of the learning and developmental growth of mokopuna.

Implement and evaluate curriculum activities to assert whakamana in an early learning environment.

- 2.1 Apply the concept of mana tangata to implement curriculum activities.
- 2.2 Apply the concept of mana tangata to evaluate curriculum activities in terms of learning and development and care of mokopuna.
