Purpose	People awarded with this unit standard will be able to evaluate own performance and practice, then develop and implement a self-management plan with whānau as an expression of rangatiratanga in an early learning environment.

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Guidance Information

Rangatiratanga in this context refers to the self-management of own professional and personal development to align with Part D in Te Whāriki.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Evaluate own performance and practice within an early learning environment with whānau.

Performance criteria

1.1 Monitor and review own performance and practice to identify areas for personal and professional development.

Range personal and professional development may include but is not limited to – *Mana whenua* - overall quality of teaching and learning environments, *Mana tangata* achievement aims and learning outcomes, *Mana aotūroa* - developing own teaching approaches and practices, use of resources, policies and processes, *Mana reo* – quality of own reo, *Mana atua* – decision making, emotional wellbeing.

Evidence of four is required.

Outcome 2

Develop and implement a self-management plan with whānau as an expression of rangatiratanga.

Performance criteria

2.1 Develop own self-management plan to inform and improve own performance and practice in an early learning environment.

Range plan may include but is not limited to – *Mana Tangata* collaboratively working with whānau, mokopuna, hapori, *Mana Atua* decision making, emotional well-being, *Mana Reo* – communication ā-waha, ā-tuhituhi, ā-pānui, *Mana Aotūroa* – self-study (directed learning), matihiko (digital), rangahau, technology, thinking and reasoning, *Mana whenua* – practise (do rehearse) and practice (habit, repetition).

Evidence of three is required.

2.2 Implement and reflect on own self-management plan with whānau.
