### Guidance Information

- 1 Definitions  
*ULD* refers to a Unit Load Device. This may include a cargo container or a pallet.  
*Organisational procedures* refer to the step-by-step instructions for implementing or carrying out an organisation's policy or desired objective.
- 2 All activities must be carried out in accordance with organisational procedures.
- 3 Legislation
  - a Any relevant Acts, regulations, and bylaws must be complied with during assessment against this standard.
  - b Legislative and/or regulatory requirements may include but are not limited to – the Civil Aviation Act 1990.
- 4 Evidence for the practical components of this standard must be gathered in an aviation workplace.

### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Prepare container park for an air cargo operation.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Park is clean, tidy and ready to receive ULDs.
- 1.2 ULDs received out of park hours are stored.
- 1.3 Equipment and resources required are checked and ready for use.

**Outcome 2**

Receive ULDs.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 ULDs are received and recorded.
- 2.2 ULDs are unloaded safely, checked for damage and the appropriate action taken.
- 2.3 ULDs are stored in the appropriate location.

**Outcome 3**

Release ULDs.

**Performance criteria**

- 3.1 ULDs are retrieved and loaded.
- 3.2 Release information is recorded.
- 3.3 Customer interaction is polite, helpful and friendly.  
  
Range customer interaction must include but is not limited – face-to-face, via the telephone.
- 3.4 Service standards are met at all times.

**Outcome 4**

Manage the container park operation in an air cargo environment.

**Performance criteria**

- 4.1 ULD inventory tasks are completed.
- 4.2 Operations within the park are conducted at all times.
- 4.3 Security within the park is maintained at all times.
