Service information may include – technical information for a vehicle, machine, or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Carry out pre-service inspections.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 The service to be carried out is identified.
- 1.2 The vehicle or machine is operated and a visual inspection is carried out to identify any faults.

1.3 Any faults identified are recorded.

Outcome 2

Service a vehicle or machine.

Range Filters may include air, fuel, oil and cabin filters.
Oil replacement includes engine and driveline oils.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 The service is carried out in accordance with applicable service information.
- 2.2 Oil, fluid and filter changes are completed.
- 2.3 Any service interval indicators are reset.
- 2.4 All service documentation is completed.
