2 Definitions

*Inspection chamber* refers to a chamber with working space at ground level through which the drain passes either as an open channel or as a pipe incorporating an inspection point.

*Job specifications* refer to instructions (oral, written, graphic) and may include any of the following – manufacturers' instructions; design drawing detail specifications; specifications from a specialist source such as an architect, designer, engineer, or a supervisor; and site or work specific requirements.

- 3 Candidates must hold a current limited certificate trainee authorisation or exemption under supervision as issued under the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 2006.

Inspection chambers are limited to wet chambers; and may include but are not limited to – pre-cast concrete, in-situ, plastic, in-line inspection chambers, drop inspection chambers.

Install inspection chambers.

# Performance criteria

- 1.1 Select appropriate inspection chambers in accordance with job specifications.
- 1.2 Position inspection chambers appropriately in accordance with job specifications.
- 1.3 Install channel, invert level between inlet and outlet, benching, and risers.
- 1.4 Use appropriate methods of jointing pipework to inspection chambers according to the materials being joined.
  - Range may include but not limited to loose sleeve/band clamped sleeve, plaster/epoxy mortar (epoxy resin), rubber ring, solvent.
- 1.5 Install lid and adjustment rings to align with height specified by plan or job specifications.
