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2 Definitions

Discharge pipework refers to pipework through which water or sewerage is pumped at pressure, (also known as a rising main).

Drainage systems refers to drainage systems for the disposal of foulwater or stormwater that are constructed to convey the collected water to an appropriate outfall, using gravity flow where possible, but other means when necessary.

- 3 Candidates must hold a current limited certificate trainee authorisation or exemption under supervision as issued under the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 2006.
- 4 Level of performance

To achieve this standard the candidate must be capable of consistently performing the requirements:

- to current and relevant legislation, standards and codes (including safety);
- in an environmentally sustainable manner;
- within an acceptable timeframe;
- in the workplace;
- in different and unfamiliar contexts.
