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### Guidance Information

- 1 **Definition**  
*Whānau Ora* is about empowering whānau to take control of their future: to be self-determining (cohesive, resilient and nurturing); confidently participating in Te Ao Māori; to be living healthy lifestyles; to be participating fully in society; and to be economically secure; with initiatives that add value, build upon the strengths and capabilities already present in the whānau, and lead to better outcomes for whānau.
- 2 *Manaakitanga* refer to the elevation of the personal qualities of others with whom we have a relationship. *Mana* can be described as the personal power and prestige that individuals have; *aki* means to uplift or encourage.
- 3 Legislation relevant to this unit standard may include but is not limited to the Treaty of Waitangi Act 1975; Health and Safety at Work Act 2015; and any subsequent changes.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Describe the concepts of manaakitanga.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Define manaakitanga in relation to whakamā and whakamana.
- 1.2 Identify how whānau are enabled through manaakitanga.
- 1.3 Demonstrate ways that you enable whānau leadership through manaakitanga.
- 1.4 Identify an example of manaakitanga within your whānau.

**Outcome 2**

Describe ways that you would engage whānau to support mana-whānau.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Define mana-whānau in relation to manaakitanga.
- 2.2 Explain how mana-whānau applies to you and your whānau.
- 2.3 Explain ways to ensure the ongoing development of mana-whānau.
