- 2 Definition

PPE refers to personal protective equipment which may include a bee suit and veil, gloves, boots, hive tool and smoker and fire extinguisher.

Workplace procedures refer to the policies and procedures set down by the employer or organisation on workplace safety, and opening and closing beehives.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare to open beehives.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Assemble and wear PPE.
- 1.2 Assemble equipment.

Range must include – including smoker, beehive tool, fire extinguisher.

Outcome 2

Open beehives and carry out beehive inspections.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Light the smoker producing a cool smoke and smoke the entrance to the beehive.
- 2.2 Open the beehive using appropriate equipment.
- 2.3 Disassemble the beehive, and remove and replace frames.
- 2.4 Undertake inspections and carry out any follow up action.
- 2.5 Follow hygiene procedures.

Outcome 3

Close beehives.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Return frames in the appropriate order and reassemble beehives minimising the risk of crushing bees and spilling wax.
- 3.2 Extinguish smoker and store, following all fire risk procedures.
- 3.3 Follow hygiene procedures.
