- 2.2 Review data and information to confirm accuracy and fit with the research plan and establish and source any further data requirements if required.
- 2.3 Analyse data and information to determine whether the results support the objectives and scope and meet the reporting requirements of the research plan.

Outcome 3

Formulate conclusions, prepare, and present the sports turf management initiative report.

Performance criteria

3.1 Determine conclusions from the data analyses in accordance with research plan objectives.
