Power tools – tools operated by direct power current or battery.

Small machinery – machinery operated by petrol, two stroke, or four stroke engines, or compressors.

Workplace procedures refer to the procedures and standards set by the client or employing organisation on operation and maintenance of power tools and machinery and must be consistent with equipment manufacturer's guidelines.

3 All evidence presented in this assessment must be in accordance with workplace procedures.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Operate and maintain power tools and small machinery used in landscape work.

Range

evidence of eight power tools is required: may include but is not limited to – tile cutter, saws, cutters, drills, nail guns, saws (circular, bench, drop), routers, disc grinders, planer;

evidence of four items of small machinery is required: may include but is not limited to – rotary hoe, concrete mixer, post hole borer, concrete cutter, compactor, line trimmer, hedge trimmer, power float.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Select and prepare power tools and small machinery for the task and site.
- 1.2 Check power tools and small machinery for safety and functionality prior to use.
- 1.3 Operate power tools and small machinery effectively, efficiently, safely, and according to manufacturer's operating instructions using the right tool for the job.
- 1.4 Demonstrate awareness of site hazards when using power tools and small machinery.
- 1.5 Wear personal protective equipment appropriate for the task.
- 1.6 Work safely around other people and machinery working on site.
- 1.7 Clean, maintain, and store tools and equipment after use.
