Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare for and lay a range of hard surfaces in landscape work.

Range hard surfaces may include but are not limited to – slate, tiles, concrete pavers, segmental pavers, concrete, brick and granite.
evidence of four hard surfaces is required using two different types of hard surfaces.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Prepare materials and equipment.

- 1.2 Prepare the work area.
Range level, excavate, edgings, base.
- 1.3 Lay the hard surfaces, as specified in plans or specifications.
- 1.4 Select, prepare, and use tools and equipment appropriate for the task.
- 1.5 Install or use safety warnings when work is accessible to the public.
- 1.6 Work safely around other people and machinery on site.
- 1.7 Remove surplus material and reinstate the site on completion of the job.
