- 2.1 Calculate the amount of stone and associated materials required.
- 2.2 Select and/or prepare stone as required and build stone features and associated construction work.

- 2.3 Select, prepare, and use tools and equipment appropriate for the task.
- 2.4 Install or use safety warnings when work is accessible to the public.
- 2.5 Work safely around other people and machinery on site.
- 2.6 Remove surplus material and reinstate the site on completion of the job.
