### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Construct brick or block features in landscape work.

Range evidence of two examples of one of the following – free standing wall, retaining wall, facings or veneers, columns and piers, steps and seats, storage feature, barbecue, fireplace, pizza oven, is required.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Calculate, select, and order materials.

- 1.2 Lay foundations appropriate to breadth and purpose of foundation.
- 1.3 Construct features and carry out associated work.
- Range associated work may include but is not limited to – drainage, backfilling, waterproofing.
- 1.4 Install fixings if required.
- 1.5 Install or use safety warnings when work is accessible to the public.
- 1.6 Select, prepare, and use the appropriate hand and power tools, and equipment for the job.
- 1.7 Remove surplus material, and reinstate the site on completion of the job.
- 1.8 Work safely around other people and machinery on site.
