- 4 Definitions
Company requirements refer to instructions to staff on policy and procedures that are available in the workplace. These requirements may include – company policies and procedures, work instructions, product quality specifications and legislative requirements.
Service information may include – technical information for a vehicle, machine, or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations.
- 5 Evidence of three separate turbocharger overhauls is required to meet the requirements for assessment of this unit standard.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Overhaul an automotive turbocharger.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Turbocharger unit is dismantled.

1.2 All parts are cleaned to enable an inspection to be carried out.

1.3 A condition report is completed.

Range inspection of parts, identifying and recording faults, recommending repairs and replacement of parts.

1.4 Rotating components are cleaned and balanced.

1.5 Parts are repaired or replaced as required.

1.6 Turbocharger unit is reassembled.

Range cleanliness, clearances, alignment marks.
