- 2 Assessment against this unit standard must take place in a workplace environment and the context must be specific to the candidate's own role on site. Assessment parameters depend on company and site-specific equipment, procedures, and practices. Practices must reflect industry best practice and comply with legislative requirements.
- 3 Definitions
Company requirements include the policy, procedures, and methodologies of the company. They include legislative and regulatory requirements that may apply across the company or to a specific site. Requirements are documented in the company health and safety plans, traffic management plans, contract work programmes, quality plans, policies, and procedural documents.
Quality plan refers to any contract specific policy, processes, procedures, testing or certification requirements.
Site safety plan means the comprehensive plan dealing with issues relating to health, safety, and the environment. This plan may be generic or site specific and will include an emergency plan. It may include a hazard register.
Work plan refers to any job specifications or plans given to the operator prior to undertaking a job.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of civil works site operations.

Range one of – earthworks, road construction, road maintenance.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Processes for civil works operations are explained in terms of the work plan and job requirements.
- 1.2 Tasks for civil works operations are explained in terms of own role and job requirements.
- 1.3 Types of plant, equipment, and materials associated with site operations are identified in terms of the requirements of the work plan.
- 1.4 The importance of the quality plan and site safety plan are explained in terms of own role and site operations.
- 1.5 Site conditions that might impact on site operations are explained in terms of the tasks to be completed.
- 1.6 The importance of crew member behaviours and practices to productivity are explained in terms of company expectations.

Outcome 2

Carry out civil works site operations.

Range one of – earthworks, road construction, road maintenance.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Pre-start checks and/or meetings are completed and tasks for the day are identified and confirmed in accordance with company requirements.
- 2.2 Designated tasks are completed in accordance with the work plan and quality plan.
- 2.3 Equipment is operated in accordance with any equipment specifications and company requirements.
- 2.4 Communication with other crew members is timely, accurate, and addresses any communication barriers effectively.
- 2.5 Timelines and documentation requirements are met in accordance with company requirements.

- 2.6 Clean-up and end-of-day checks are completed in accordance with company requirements.
- 2.7 Debrief is attended and any feedback is discussed with a leading hand or supervisor in accordance with company requirements.
