- 2.4 Progress against the work plan is reviewed, and action is taken to minimise impact of arising issues on work processes and timelines in accordance with contract specifications and industry requirements.
- 2.5 Progress of work is recorded and reported, and achievement of objectives, outcomes, and general and special conditions of contract is verified in accordance with contract specifications and industry requirements.
