*Contract specifications* include plans, diagrams, and special technical conditions. They do not include special administrative conditions.

*Industry requirements* may refer to but are not limited to relevant policies, processes, methodologies, industry codes of practice, site specific health and safety plans, standard operating procedures, site safety plans, quality plans, work plans, traffic management plans, contract work programmes, job safety analysis, safe work method statements, job instructions, manufacturer's requirements, contract specifications, manuals, procedural documents.

*Industry standards* are documents that set out detailed requirements for specific types of work, and may include standards published at <http://www.standards.govt.nz> and/or industry specifications set by peak bodies such as NZ Transport Agency.

### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of industry best practice for an infrastructure works sector.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 The relationship between Acts of Parliament, Regulations, Rules, Standards, approved codes of practice and best or good practice guidelines is described and explained as it applies to a sector of the infrastructure industry.

- 1.2 Licencing and certification requirements that apply to a sector of the infrastructure industry are described and explained in terms of industry requirements and impact on work, supervision, and training practices.
- 1.3 Formal training that applies to a sector of the infrastructure industry is identified and explained in terms of its relationship to industry best practice, contract specifications, and industry requirements.
- 1.4 The purpose and requirements of specific industry best practice documents are explained in terms of their implications for supervision of daily operations on an infrastructure worksite.
- Range best or good practice guidelines, approved codes of practice, industry standards;  
evidence of two documents is required
- 1.5 Ramifications of non-compliance with industry best practice are explained in terms of legislative consequences and impacts on supervision of operational activities.
- 1.6 Ongoing monitoring and recording of implementation of industry best practice in own workplace is described in accordance with industry requirements.
