Outcome 1

Prepare to maintain roads clear of ice and snow.

Performance criteria

1.1 Road condition is inspected and surfaces that require treatment are identified and located. The type of treatment is determined in accordance with contract specifications and company requirements.

- 1.2 Plant and equipment are selected in accordance with type of treatment and company requirements.
- 1.3 Site management and communication requirements are identified and confirmed as in place before commencement of work.

Range site safety plan, environmental plan, traffic management plan.

Outcome 2

Maintain roads clear of ice.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Grit or chemical ice treatment is applied to road surface to ensure traction for vehicles in accordance with contract specifications and company requirements.
- 2.2 Site is monitored and any need for further treatment is determined and treatment applied on an ongoing basis until ice hazard is over, in accordance with contract specifications and company requirements.
- 2.3 Any grit is removed and site is left safe in accordance with contract specifications and company requirements.
- 2.4 Documentation is completed in accordance with contract specifications and company requirements.

Outcome 3

Maintain roads clear of snow.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Road surface is cleared of snow using a plough or grader to ensure road is safely passable for vehicles in accordance with contract specifications and company requirements.
- 3.2 Site is monitored and any need for further clearing is determined and actioned on an ongoing basis until snow hazard is over, in accordance with contract specifications and company requirements.
- 3.3 Documentation is completed in accordance with contract specifications and company requirements.
