1.2 Describe the packing requirements for live seafood.

Range procedures may include but are not limited to – product checks prior to packing, packaging type, packing process, species welfare requirements, labelling, documentation; evidence of three is required.

1.3 Describe the consequences of incorrectly packing live seafood product.

Range evidence of two is required.

Outcome 2

Pack live seafood for transport.

Performance criteria

2.1 Pack live seafood for transport.

Range may include but is not limited to – product checks prior to packing, packaging type, packing process, species welfare requirements, closure, labelling, documentation, vehicle checks; evidence of four is required.
