Industry bodies refers to organisations that play a role within an industry in a regulatory, support or advisory capacity. This includes regulatory bodies, industry training organisations and trade or professional associations.
- 2 Knowledge of at least two BCATS industries must be demonstrated.

- 1.4 Relationships between the selected industries are described in terms of crossover and compatibility.
- 1.5 Industry bodies involved in the selected industries are identified, and their impacts on those who work in the industries are described.
