- 1.1 Carry out horticulture activities according to workplace procedures.

Range	horticulture activities may include but not limited to – stake young plants, fit spray guards, attach or remove bird netting, lay reflective film, establish artificial shelter or shade cloth; evidence of at least two horticulture activities is required.
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- 1.2 Follow work instructions and request clarification if required.
- 1.3 Participate effectively in a team.
