*Horticulture operation* refers to a specific horticulture production and service industry, for example an orchard, nursery, post-harvest facility or recreational grounds.

*Workplace procedures* – the verbal or written instructions to staff on the procedures for carrying out horticulture activities including use of equipment and documentation.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Assist with routine activities when undertaking development work in a horticulture operation.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Carry out routine activities according to workplace procedures.

Range routine activities may include but not limited to – mark out block specifications, identify post holes, run out wires, attach wires; evidence of four routine activities is required.

1.2 Follow work instructions and request clarification if required.

1.3 Participate effectively in a team.

Range focus on team objectives, support team members, respond to feedback, cooperate with other team members; evidence of at least two required.
