Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Trim hooves and apply an animal husbandry device to a pig.

Performance criteria

1.1 Move, handle and restrain a sow or boar safely in preparation for husbandry procedures, with minimal stress to the animal.

1.2 Attach an animal husbandry device to a pig with minimum distress to the animal.

Range evidence must include either applying a nose ring or ear tag.

- 1.3 Trim and treat hooves of sows and boars in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 1.4 Identify and treat any animals with complications following on farm husbandry procedures.

Outcome 2

Carry out selection of replacement pig breeding stock.

Performance criteria

2.1 Identify and check physical conformation and health of breeding stock.

Range must include – legs, feet, genetic conditions, external genitalia, teats.

2.2 Record and report results of checks.
