Production plan the plan to establish routines required for numbers of sows mated, farrowed, piglets weaned, and market pigs sold to make the most efficient use of the available pig farm facilities. The production plan will include KPIs.

Production target – number and/or rate for a specified level of performance, for example, piglets born per week.

Veterinary guidelines – advice received directly from veterinarians, or literature recommended by veterinarians or providers accredited to assess against this unit standard.

Workplace procedures – the verbal or written instructions to staff on procedures for pig health, welfare, and management.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Implement, monitor, report on, and amend a pig farm production plan to optimise production.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Implement the production plan to meet the required pig farm production targets and KPIs.
- 1.2 Monitor and analyse KPIs against variations from production targets.
- 1.3 Maintain reports of KPIs.
- 1.4 Make recommendations or take action, in association with the farm manager or owner, to remedy sub optimal performance.
- 1.5 Participate in amending the pig farm production plan, with the farm manager or owner, to optimise production.
