Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Visually appraise, apply identification to, and treat pig breeding stock.

Range replacement females and boars.

Performance criteria

1.1 Visually appraise the breeding herd and identify the required number of pig breeding stock replacements.

Range feet, legs, teats, genitalia, abnormalities.

1.2 Apply identification devices to selected pig breeding stock replacements.

Range ear tags, ear notches; evidence of one is required.

1.3 Apply routine preventative health treatments to selected breeding stock replacements.

Range one of – vaccination, parasite control.

1.4 Record identification and treatment details of selected breeding stock replacements.

Outcome 2

Select market pigs for sale and check their fitness for transport.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Select market pigs which are within the weight range to meet market requirements and maximise return.
- 2.2 Check market pigs are fit for transport in accordance with NZ Pork Fit to Load Guidelines and Animal Status Declaration requirements.

Outcome 3

Supply and confirm information for the receivers of market pigs, and arrange transport of market pigs.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Supply and confirm information with the receivers.
- 3.2 Arrange transport to collect market pigs for delivery to the destination at the agreed time.

Outcome 4

Prepare and load market pigs for transport and sale.

Performance criteria

4.1 Provide final feed to market pigs before transporting at appropriate time.

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- 4.2 Move market pigs to the loadout area prior to transport arrival with minimal stress and without injury.
- 4.3 Record sale details of market pigs.
- 4.4 Carry out loading of market pigs with minimal stress and without injury to pigs or handler(s).
