They may include but are not limited to – standard operating procedures, site specific procedures, site safety procedures, equipment operating procedures, quality assurance procedures, product quality specifications, references, approved codes of practice, housekeeping standards, environmental considerations, on-site briefings, supervisor's instructions, and procedures to comply with legislative and local body requirements relevant to the furniture industry sector.

Prepare to construct an upholstered furniture carcase.

1.1 Job specifications are obtained and interpreted.

3.1 Finished upholstered furniture carcase is checked for quality in accordance with job specifications.

- 3.2 Work area is left cleaned and cleared of tools, debris, and excess material.
- 3.3 Supervisor is informed of completion of job.
