- 1.4 The automatic poultry production machine is loaded and operated to meet quality and throughput workplace production requirements.
- 1.5 Variations in product, equipment faults, and workplace hazards are reported.
- 1.6 The automatic poultry production machine is switched off where required.
- 1.7 Machine, materials, and work area are left ready for the next user.
