System – refers to procedures or processes used to support operational activities in the manufacture of dairy products but not directly related to the manufacture of dairy products.

Systems may include but are not limited to – maintenance requests, health and safety recording, leave requests, inventory checks, ordering consumable items, recording plant status, product specification reviews, audit checks.

Range evidence of three support systems is required.

3.2 Input data into systems.

Range timeliness, accuracy and compliance;
evidence of three support systems is required.
