<b>Purpose</b>	People credited with this unit standard are able to demonstrate knowledge of: the whakapapa of fish; the principles of kaitiakitanga for fish; the historical and contemporary use of parts of fish; and the natural habitat and feeding requirements of finned fish and shellfish.

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### Guidance Information

For the purposes of assessment

- evidence of disciplines of tikanga are applied and consultation with tangata whenua is required to validate assessment activities.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of the whakapapa of fish.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Identify and describe whakapapa of fish in accordance with whānau, hapū and iwi tikanga and kawa.

Range whakapapa of fish includes but is not limited to – the three major phases of the creation history covering Te Kore, Te Po, Ranginui and Papa, and the war among the Atua that led to the first division of reptile and fish.

#### Outcome 2

Demonstrate knowledge of the principles of kaitiakitanga for fish.

#### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Identify and describe kaitiakitanga for fish in terms of iwi and hapu tikanga, and kawa.

**Outcome 3**

Demonstrate knowledge of the historical and contemporary use of parts of fish.

**Performance criteria**

3.1 Identify and describe the parts of a finned fish.

Range includes but is not limited to – fins, scales, gills, bones, roe, intestines, liver, skin, teeth.

3.2 Identify and describe the parts of a shellfish.

Range includes but is not limited to – shell, muscle, gut.

3.3 Identify and describe the historical use of parts of finned fish and shellfish.

Range evidence of at least six parts is required.

3.4 Identify and describe the contemporary use of all parts of finned fish and shellfish.

Range evidence of at least three commercial scale activities is required.

**Outcome 4**

Demonstrate knowledge of the natural habitat and feeding requirements of finned fish and shellfish.

**Performance criteria**

4.1 Identify and describe the natural habitat and food supplies of freshwater finned fish.

4.2 Identify and describe the natural habitat and food supplies of saltwater finned fish.

4.3 Identify and describe the natural habitat and food supplies of shellfish.
