1 Assessment

Evidence for this standard must reflect commercial competence.

Commercial competence refers to the ability to demonstrate knowledge and skills in the context of the currently accepted requirements of a business operating in a commercial environment.

Commercial competence must be confirmed by a tradesperson with current expertise in the resin flooring application trade.

2 Definition

Manufacturer's application guidelines include all the relevant application information for a specific resin flooring system.

Workplace procedures refers to the documented procedures specific to a workplace which sets out the standard and the required practices of that workplace.
