1 Assessment

This unit standard is intended to align with the *New Zealand Certificate in Flooring Surface Preparation – Specifications* and the New Zealand Certificate in Flooring Surface Preparation (Level 4) [Ref: 4299].

Evidence for this standard must reflect commercial competence.

Commercial competence refers to the ability to demonstrate knowledge and skills in the context of the currently accepted requirements of a business operating in a commercial environment.

Commercial competence must be confirmed by a person with current expertise in the flooring surface preparation trade.

2 Definitions

Manufacturer's installation guidelines include all the relevant producer information for a specific timber floor installation.

Workplace procedures refers to the documented procedures specific to a workplace which sets out the standard and the required practices of that workplace.

Topical coatings do not include waterproofing systems, resin coatings, underlayment or cementitious systems.
