2 Definitions

Established sports turf – sports turf that is greater than one year old. Workplace procedures – policies and procedures on safety and operation, and guidelines set down by the employer, host organisation, or codes for maintaining established sports turf areas. Workplace procedures should reflect equipment manufacturer's requirements, and current legislation.

- 3 For the purposes of assessment:
 - this unit standard must be assessed in a commercial sports turf workplace or simulated commercial sports turf situation.
 - the sports turf maintenance area should be a minimum of 100 square metres.
 - evidence must be presented in accordance with workplace procedures.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Maintain established sports turf.

Range for a period of at least eight weeks.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Maintain optimum growing conditions by application of fertilisers and water.
- 1.2 Control pests, weeds, and diseases.
- 1.3 Cut turf to required height.
- 1.4 Use tools and equipment appropriate for the task.
- 1.5 Clean and store tools, equipment, and machinery after use.

Outcome 2

Prepare established sports turf surfaces for play.

Performance criteria

2.1 Prepare sports turf surfaces for play.
