- 1.1 Job instructions and site set-up are checked and confirmed, and materials and tools are selected.
- 1.2 Network flow is reduced or stopped to allow work to take place in accordance with job instructions.
- 1.3 Excavation and any required groundwater control are carried out.
- 1.4 Pipe clearing and unblocking are carried out in accordance with job instructions.
- 1.5 Pipes, fittings, and joints are installed and tested in accordance with job instructions.
- 1.6 Backfill, compaction and reinstatement are completed in accordance with job instructions.
- 1.7 Work on structures is completed in accordance with job instructions.
