*Wine style characteristics* refer to colour, aroma, flavour and other characteristics developed in the wine making process.

*Workplace procedures* refer to policies and procedures on safety, operation, and production set down by the employer or host organisation.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Describe wine growing techniques that influence grape quality specifications and wine style characteristics.

Range evidence of three techniques is required;  
evidence of two either from a grape variety and/or rootstock is required.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Describe wine growing techniques associated with grape varieties and/or rootstocks in terms of achieving grape quality specifications and wine style characteristics.

**Outcome 2**

Monitor implementation and assess wine growing techniques.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Monitor the implementation of wine growing techniques.
- 2.2 Identify out-of-specification performance as defined by grape quality specifications.
- 2.3 Assess and respond to out-of-specification performance in accordance with grape quality specifications.
- 2.4 Report remedies to resolve out-of-specification performance.
