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### Guidance Information

- 1 Texts can be oral and/or visual and must be of sufficient length and complexity to provide adequate evidence of competence. Texts must be identified and/or submitted for moderation purposes.
- 2 **Definition**  
*Understand* means the candidate can extract meaning from non-written texts. It is not a test of memory. The text may be referenced and accessed during assessment against the standard.
- 3 **Ranges**  
Oral texts may include – radio programmes, drama productions, audiobooks, podcasts, oral performance.  
Visual texts may include – film, digital/online media, television programmes, live lecture.
- 4 All activities relevant to this standard must reflect ngā kaupapa o te Tiriti o Waitangi (the principles of the Treaty of Waitangi).
- 5 All activities must, as relevant to candidates and/or this standard, reflect the peoples of the Pacific and other cultures, and their world views.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Understand and assess non-written texts on a topic.

Range three texts.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Each non-written text is summarised in terms of content relevant to the specified topic.

- 1.2 The relevance of each non-written text to the specified topic is assessed in terms of its usefulness, credibility, interest, and currency.
