- 2 Definition

Landscape plan may be either drawn, verbal instruction or a written brief.

Workplace procedures refer to the procedures and standards set by the client or employing organisation for landscape design and must be consistent with manufacturers guidelines and current legislation.

- 3 Range

Candidates must complete a sketch of at least a total of four landscape features which may include finishing details.

evidence is required of at least one hard and one soft landscape feature

Features may include – hard landscaping - drainage plan, retaining wall, deck, steps, block and brick work, fireplace, water feature, pergola, fences, screens; soft landscaping – large tree planting, planting plan.

- 4 For the purposes of assessment:
 - evidence must be presented in accordance with workplace procedures;
 - sketches must be hand drawn.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Develop sketches on site of hard and soft landscape features to assist interpretation of the landscape plan.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Specify dimensions and location of landscape features in the sketch.
- 1.2 Identify the types and quality of materials required in the sketch.
- 1.3 Present the sketches in a two-dimensional format.
