Guidance Information

1 Definitions

Legislative requirements refer to the obligations of the employer and/or employee under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and Health (Hairdressers) Regulations 1980.

Workplace requirements mean the practices prescribed by management as being the quality standards for client contact and work organisation for a particular salon.

In this unit standard all work must comply with legislative requirements and must ensure optimum hair condition and maximum client comfort at all times.

3 Range

A commercially acceptable timeframe varies for different hairdressing services. Times reflect performance required to support a commercial salon's profitability. A commercially acceptable timeframe for applying, processing, and removing permanent hair colour is a maximum of one hour and forty-five minutes.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Complete an in-depth consultation and prepare client for a contemporary colouring service.

Performance criteria

1.1 Service outcome is identified and confirmed in consultation with the client, and client is protected for the required service in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and the expectations of the salon environment.

Range consultation must include – pre-quoting (time, money), service

journey, time allowances, maintenance;

includes but is not limited to use of – visual aids, colour chart.

1.2 The hair and scalp are analysed.

Range porosity, elasticity, texture, density, length, scalp conditions,

percentage of white, natural and artificial colour, reflect, previous chemical services, other additives, medical or other factors that

can affect the hair and skin.

1.3 Permanent colour and integrated colour techniques are selected that meet the confirmed service outcome, commercial expectations and manufacturer's instructions.

Range may include but not limited to – root melts, balayage, multi-tonal

colouring.

- 1.4 Permanent colour is selected that meets confirmed service outcome, industry expectations and manufacturer's instructions.
- 1.5 An allergy test is completed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and documented.

Outcome 2

Prepare to apply permanent hair colour.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Hair is prepared for the permanent colour application in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and confirmed service outcome.
- 2.2 Developer is selected in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and confirmed outcome.

Range must include – use of at least two different colour formulations to

create colour variation.

2.3 Hair colour and developer are measured and mixed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and confirmed outcome.

Outcome 3

Apply permanent hair colour using colouring techniques.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Permanent hair colour application and processing is completed in accordance with hair and scalp analysis and manufacturer's instructions to ensure even coverage, and the confirmed outcome.
- 3.2 Permanent hair colour is applied, processed, and removed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and to meet confirmed outcome and ensure hair protection, within a commercially acceptable timeframe.

Outcome 4

Complete the service experience.

Performance criteria

- 4.1 Hair is prepared for the following finishing service in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
 - Range includes but is not limited to contemporary blow dry or set.
- 4.2 Home haircare advice is provided consistent with client's hair type and completed service.
 - Range product type, maintenance advice, opportunity to rebook.
- 4.3 Client history is updated in accordance with workplace requirements.
- 4.4 Tools and equipment are sanitised in accordance with workplace requirements.
- 4.5 The work areas are cleaned and tidied in accordance with workplace requirements.
