- 2 Assessment

Evidence for this unit standard must reflect commercial competence; the ability to demonstrate knowledge and skills in the context of the currently accepted requirements of a business operating in a commercial environment.

Evidence must also reflect commercial standards; the verbal and written information covering company policy, standard operating procedures and processes and job-specific instructions.

This unit standard must be assessed under the supervision of a commercially competent practitioner in workplace conditions that reflect:

- commercial standards, current health, safety, industry, and workplace requirements; and
- industry requirements for commercially acceptable timeframes.

3 Definitions

Fixtures and fittings refer to hardware, appliances, splash backs, specialty lighting, benchtops, ducting.

Kitchen joinery work refers to cabinetry that is fixed and may include bathroom, laundry, storage solutions, or wardrobe components.

Specialist installation work refers to work done on top of the general cabinetry installation that is specific to the job.

Workplace requirements refer to the documented procedures specific to a workplace that which sets set out the standard and the required practices of that workplace.

This may include job specifications, procedures, practices, manufacturer recommendations, technical data sheets, material safety data sheets.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Install kitchen joinery.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Site is re-measured, checked against working drawings, and any changes are recorded and confirmed with a supervisor and the site supervisor.
- 1.2 Kitchen joinery is re-assembled and set out in correct position in accordance with the working drawings.
- 1.3 Provision for basic plumbing and electrical work is completed in accordance with own role and responsibilities.
- 1.4 Specialist installation work specific to the job is completed in accordance with the working drawings.

Range walls, ceilings, floors.
- 1.5 On site scribing, finishing, and attaching of fixtures and fittings is completed in accordance with the working drawings.
- 1.6 Protection is applied to the kitchen cabinetry in accordance with the working drawings.
- 1.7 Final check by the site supervisor or client is completed and any changes, feedback or recommendations for improvement are recorded and communicated to a supervisor.
