3 Definitions

Company requirements refer to instructions to staff on policy and procedures which are documented in memo or manual format and are available in the workplace. Service information may include but is not limited to – technical information of a vehicle, machine, or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions and specifications; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations. This may be accessed from the manufacturer.

Suitable tools and equipment refer to industry approved tools and equipment that are recognised within the industry as being the most suited to complete the task in a professional and competent manner with due regard to safe working practices.

4 Range

Safely removing adhesive graphics may include – recognition of prior damage to paint or panel is recorded, use of heat, use of scrapers, multiple-layer finish, doorframe tape.

Evidence is required of three adhesive graphics removals.

2.1 Safely remove adhesive graphics using suitable tools and equipment without damage to the paint and/or panel.

Range may include use of – scrapers, heat gun, infrared, solvent for

removing residue adhesive.
