2 Definitions

Associated equipment refers to any equipment other than a gas appliance which must be installed as part of an appliance installation. May include but is not limited to – flues, ventilation, connections, valves, regulators, pressure testing points, mounting and restraints.

Gas appliances refer to gas appliances that generally have an input rating below 250MJ/h and may be electronically or manually controlled.

Job specifications refer to instructions (oral, written, graphic) and may include any of the following: manufacturer instructions; design drawing detail specifications; specifications from a specialist source such as an architect, designer, engineer, or a supervisor; and site or work specific requirements.

- 3 Credit for this unit standard does not entitle the candidate to legally perform certain electrical aspects of this work unless registered or supervised by a registered person under the provisions of the Electricity Act 1992.

 - Range includes but is not limited to verification of gas supply, air supply for safe operation, and appliance and manufacturer's installation specification.
- 2.2 Explain the appliance specific factors that affect the selection and positioning of each appliance type.
- 2.3 Explain the appliance specific procedure for testing and connection to the gas supply.
- 2.4. Explain the appliance specific factors that affect the selection and positioning of flues for each appliance type.

Outcome 3

Demonstrate knowledge of commissioning gas appliances and associated equipment.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Describe how gas appliance commissioning is carried out.
- 3.2 Describe methods of testing flues.
- 3.3 Describe how ventilation requirements are confirmed and calculated.
- 3.4 Explain the post installation documentation and customer handover process to be completed.
