Performance criteria

1.1 Items to be washed are prioritised according to enterprise procedures.

1.2 Load type is identified.

Range soil type, soil level, stain type, fabric composition, fabric colour.

- 1.3 Washer start-up procedure is performed according to enterprise procedures.
- 1.4 Washer is operated according to laundry load type requirements.
- 1.5 Washer is monitored to maintain machine performance and wash standards according to enterprise procedures.
- 1.6 Washer shut-down procedure is performed according to manufacturer's instructions.
- 1.7 Documentation requirements are completed according to enterprise procedures.
