## Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Run out, join and set up fence netting.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Roll out netting along entire fence line without damage and in a controlled manner.
- 1.2 Join netting ends with no protrusions.
- 1.3 Prepare netting with wider wire spacings at the top of the fence, allowing unrestricted straining and adjustment before termination.
- 1.4 Position termination knots according to assembly type to avoid slack.

### Outcome 2

Tension and terminate fence netting.

## Performance criteria

- 2.1 Place netting clamps on netting against stay wire, and secure to prevent slip or wire damage.
- 2.2 Complete the pre-termination line check prior to final tensioning.
- 2.3 Tension netting with no vertical distortion.
- 2.4 Terminate line wires and retain tension when netting clamps are removed.

# Outcome 3

Staple fence netting.

# Performance criteria

- 3.1 Position the netting height according to fence design.
- 3.2 Skew staples with minimum wire clearance and maintain true staple loading to all primary and intermediate posts.
- 3.3 Maintain ground clearance in a uniform manner.
- 3.4 Staple wire to post without damage in accordance with post loading.
- 3.5 Identify netting section requiring alteration and achieve the required adjustment.
