<b>Purpose</b>	People credited with this unit standard are able to clean aircraft interiors; and complete activities related to cleaning tasks.

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### Guidance Information

- 1 All tasks must be carried out in accordance with enterprise procedures.
- 2 Definition  
*Enterprise procedures* – procedures used by the organisation carrying out the work and applicable to the tasks being carried out. Examples are – standard operating procedures, safety procedures, equipment operating procedures, codes of practice, quality management practices and standards, procedures to comply with legislative and local body requirements.
- 3 Aircraft interiors may include cabin, cargo area, cockpit, windows.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Clean aircraft interiors.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Aircraft to be cleaned is identified by matching aircraft registration with documentation.
- 1.2 Resources are selected, obtained, and checked for serviceability and status.  
 Range may include but is not limited to – publications, tools, cleaning materials, cleaning equipment, safety equipment and clothing.
- 1.3 Aircraft is prepared for cleaning.  
 Range lights, power supply.
- 1.4 Aircraft interiors are cleaned.

**Outcome 2**

Complete activities related to cleaning tasks.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Tools, materials, and equipment are checked and returned to service, storage or disposed of.
- 2.2 Completion activities specific to the task and work area are carried out.
- Range may include but is not limited to – tool control, cleanliness, tidiness, return of publications, preparation for next activity.
- 2.3 Documentation is completed.
