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Guidance Information

- 1 All tasks must be carried out in accordance with enterprise procedures.

Enterprise procedures – procedures used by the organisation carrying out the work and applicable to the tasks being carried out. Examples are – standard operating procedures, safety procedures, equipment operating procedures, codes of practice, quality management practices and standards, procedures to comply with legislative and local body requirements.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Remove aircraft from storage.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Aircraft is identified by matching registration with servicing documentation.
- 1.2 Resources are obtained and checked for serviceability or status.

Range	may include but is not limited to – publications, tools, materials, equipment.
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- 1.3 Aircraft is removed from storage.

Range	may include but is not limited to – doors and/or panels are opened and closed; blanks, locks, chocks and covers are removed, stowed and/or fitted; bonding leads and isolation tags are connected and disconnected; inhibitors are removed.
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Outcome 2

Prepare aircraft for service.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Aircraft is prepared for service.
- Range position aircraft, inspect for condition.
- 2.2 Any defects are identified, located and reported.
- 2.3 Resources are checked and returned to service, storage or disposed of.
- 2.4 Documentation is completed.
