Performance criteria

- 1.1 Aircraft is identified by matching registration with servicing documentation.
- 1.2 Resources are obtained and checked for serviceability or status.

Range may include but is not limited to – publications, tools, materials, equipment.

Outcome 2

Prepare aircraft for service.

Range position aircraft, inspect for condition.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Any defects are identified, located and reported.
- 2.2 Resources are checked and returned to service, storage or disposed of.
- 2.3 Documentation is completed.
