2 Definitions

Window schedule – window requirements documented from building plans and drawings.

Outcome 1

Produce quotations for aluminium joinery products.

Range evidence of at least two quotations for different jobs is required.

Performance criteria

1.1 Options are selected to comply with window schedule in accordance with job specifications.

Range schedule may include – standard frames, non-standard frames, extras, colour, glass type, wind zone, cladding type, reveal type,

special considerations.

- 1.2 Window schedule is used as a production reference in accordance with company procedures.
- 1.3 Price is established in accordance with company procedures.
- 1.4 Quote is verified against specifications, initial data, production plan, and customer requirements in accordance with company procedures.
- 1.5 Data is saved in accordance with company procedures.

Outcome 2

Produce customer and production documentation.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Quality management procedures for quotations are explained in accordance with company procedures.
- 2.2 The consequences of errors in quotations are explained in accordance with company procedures.

Range consequences include – customer service, company goals, costs to production.

- 2.3 Quotation is presented to customer in accordance with company procedures.
- 2.4 Data is amended as required in accordance with negotiated variations to plans, prices, and/or site measure details.
- 2.5 Final quotation is verified by customer, sales, and production staff in accordance with company procedures.
- 2.6 Production documentation is produced and saved in accordance with company procedures.
 - Range documentation includes cutting sheets, assembly reports, quantities lists, price lists, stock requirements, specific data reports.

2.7 Quotation is sent to customer and saved in accordance with company procedures.

Range saving includes – customer copy, company copy, cover letters.

Outcome 3

Manage computer files for effective administration and cost control of aluminium joinery product quotations.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Client files are set up, amended, and saved in accordance with company procedures.
- 3.2 Item and quotation files are set up, amended, saved, and archived in accordance with company procedures.
- 3.3 Product details are updated with information from suppliers in accordance with company procedures.
- 3.4 Company costs and prices are updated as directed by management in accordance with company procedures.
